SERVICE CONTRACT ACT

Service Contract Act wages shall be paid for this work as directed by Wage Determination No. 05-2531 Rev (01).

SCHEDULES

Notice of Award is anticipated approximately three (3) calendar day after receipt of proposals.

The performance periods included in the individual Statements of Work shall apply.

AWARD

Award will be made on the basis of the lowest priced offer submitted for each of the three separate pieces of work or all three pieces combined, whichever is the best interest of Stoller and the DOE, by a qualified, responsible and responsive offeror. Stoller reserves the right to reject any or all offers and to waive informalities and minor irregularities to offers received. Stoller reserves the right to reject unbalanced offers.

SUBCONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY DETERMINATION

Stoller will determine subcontractor and lower tier subcontractor's responsibility to successfully and safely perform this project through various means. Factors to be considered include, but are not limited to safety, past performance, references, and qualifications. Solicitations that require special standards of responsibility will include qualification requirements in the statement of work.

Safety performance shall be evaluated based on information provided on the OSHA 300 and 300A forms, the Worker's Compensation Experience Modification Rate (EMR) and performance reviews for previous projects. The evaluation shall take into consideration the OSHA total recordable case rate, the number of cases, rate and number of lost workday cases, number of lost workdays, severity of injuries, repetitive nature of injuries, and workers compensation factor based on the EMR. As a standard, the subcontractor should have a recordable case rate not exceeding 2.0 and an EMR not exceeding 1.0 (averaged over the past three complete years). Companies with higher rates will require review and approval of Stoller Management. A work sheet is included with this package for the OSHA forms and EMR.

Responsibility determinations shall be solely at the discretion of S. M. Stoller and shall not be subject to dispute. Stoller reserves the right to deny award to any company that is deemed non-responsible.

If you have previously submitted this information as part of a prequalification package, note that on your proposal, and unless there are changes to that information or a later year information is available, it is not necessary to resubmit. Previous submittal of this information should not be deemed as a prequalification to perform this work.

NOTE

Any references in the Terms and Conditions for Construction Subcontracts to Colorado should be replaced with Utah.
