Moab UMTRA Project Environmental Policy

The purpose of this policy is to demonstrate the Moab Uranium Mill Tailings Remedial Action (UMTRA) Project's commitment to ensure a safe and protective environment for workers and the public through everyday sustainable practices that adhere to applicable environmental protection laws, regulations, and standards. We will ensure transparency of our actions and decisions while implementing the following principles for ethical and responsible environmental stewardship:

- Conduct our operations in an environmentally sound manner that is protective of the air, water, land, and other natural and cultural resources;
- Maintain compliance with requirements, guidance, and standards relating to Environmental Management Systems and Integrated Safety Management;
- Identify and protect workers and the public from hazards associated with environmental risks;
